

To read undisturbed.

In the summer, I love chilling out and reading on my balcony. I enjoy a warm day, but I can do without the glare of the sun and prying eyes from my neighbours – so I just press a button to extend my PM^{IIght}, and then I can focus on myself and whatever I'm reading. If later on the sun gets a bit lower in the sky, all I have to do is lower the side awnings on the foot supports to continue enjoying the peace of my retreat.

The side zip ensures there's no light gap between the awning fabric and the rail. And the front drop profile is also flush, making the PM^{light} a reliable awning offering full protection from unwanted sunshine and light rain. Even if your favourite place can be windy, the robust foot supports keep you protected in wind speeds up to 48 km/h (wind resistance class 3).

I feel sheltered under the PM^{light} – in the sun, when it's windy and even in light rain.
